Adventures in Blacksmithing

Coughing on thick, sulfur-yellow plumes of smoke, sweat dripping from my sooty brow, shoulder aching from hammering, I couldn't help but smile with contentment. I may have found my craft calling.

As I stood over the forge, heating my iron bar stock, I was excitedly thinking of all the fantastic and useful items—for both a medieval and a modern world that I could make. One S hook down, I was ready to move on to another project. Tent stakes? No, we need too many to make in a one-day class. Cabinet door handles? Definitely someday, but I want them to look the same, and I need more skill to achieve that. And then our instructor, master blacksmith Willard Smith, told us we would be making fire rakes. Well, alright. Why not?

I heated my iron, banged out both ends to the appropriate thickness, heating it again and again during the process; and then I began adding the curves, taking immense pride in what I had shaped and forged by my own hand.

Our final project was supposed to be a large door handle, but I spied a BBQ flipper on the table and was immediately intrigued. Also, to be completely honest, the thought of flattening out 8–10 inches of 3/4-inch bar stock did not sound nearly as enjoyable as working with 1/4-inch round stock toward the end of class. So with instruction from Willard, I cut off two feet of round stock and set to work making a handle on one end and tapering the other to a point sharp enough to hook a slab of meat.

At the end of the day, we went home with one wall hook, two S hooks, two fire rakes, two BBQ flippers, and an immeasurable amount of self-satisfaction.

I've spent the idle moments of the last few days looking at plans for a backyard brick forge. After all, we already have the fire rakes.
