On the last weekend in October, we plan to travel across the western border to Meridies' Gatalop event, held in historic Fort Gaines on Dauphin Island. We will bring the Baronial pavilion and will set it up for barracks-style accommodations for any Oldenfelders who wish to attend the event with us. Simply bring an air mattress or cot and set up inside the pavilion. We will be able to set up inside the fort, which promises to be an unrivaled SCA camping experience.

Our next event will be Martinmas Moot at Camp La Llanaqa in Lake Wales. This will be Fall Crown Lyst. #L Philomena is the autocrat for the event and will need assistance from all Oldenfelders in attendance to help the weekend run smoothly. We will be preparing feast on Saturday and would also be appreciative of assistance. Let's all work together to show Trimaris how The Land of Big Fun does things!

December holds still more activities for Oldenfeld. The first weekend in December will be the investiture of

Marcaster's new Coronets, Tristrum de Kerjean and Eadaoin inghean Fhuinche. We will be collecting donations for a gift basket and plan to attend the event. The following weekend will be a fighter practice and demo in Tom Brown Park, as we prepare for Yule the weekend after that. And remember, this year, Yule will once again be a full weekend event! Mission Statement and Core Values

At the July, 2018 quarterly meeting of the SCA Board of Directors the following actions were taken:

Mission Statement and SCA Statement of Core Values

The following Mission Statement was passed by the Board and replaces the current Mission Statement immediately:

The Society for Creative Anachronism (SCA) is an international non-profit volunteer educational organization. SCA is devoted to the research and re-creation of pre-seventeenth century skills, arts, combat, and culture, focused on Western Europe and its cultural contacts, and employing knowledge of history to enrich the lives of participants

through events, demonstrations, and other educational presentations and activities.

In connection with the new Mission Statement, the following Statement of Core Values was also passed by the Board:

In pursuing its mission, the SCA is committed to excellence in its programs, communications and activities and to

- act in accordance with the chivalric virtues of honor and service;
- value and respect the worth and dignity of all individuals;
- practice inclusiveness and respect pluralism and diversity;
- promote a safe and respectful environment for all SCA events;
- act with transparency, fairness,

integrity and honesty;

- be a responsible steward of SCA resources; and,
- be committed to maintaining the trust of its members and participants.

It is the expectation of the SCA that its members and participants, in all events and activities of the SCA, will conduct themselves in accordance with these tenets.

Hate Speech & Hate Symbols

The following amendment to Corpora was passed by the Board and is considered effective immediately. Hate Speech Policy
Hate speech is not tolerated in the Society. Hate speech is speech or symbols that offend, threaten, or insult

individuals or groups, based on race, color, religion, national origin, sexual orientation, disability or other traits. Such symbols and speech have no essential part of any discussion of ideas and are of so little value to the Society that any benefit that may be derived from them is clearly outweighed by the harm caused. This use by any participant in the Society may result in possible sanctions up to and including revocation of membership and denial of participation. Please report any possible instances of hate speech to your Kingdom Seneschal, the Society Seneschal or the President of the SCA immediately. 


