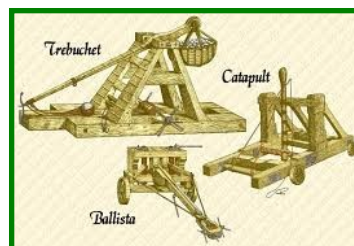
Trois, and Octavio de Flores & Mairi Celidh, as the proud lineage of Oldenfeld's Landed Nobility.

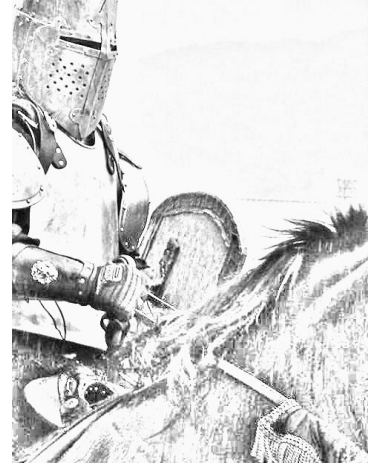
