Scott@ScottHumphries.com. In time, it would be my hope that my deputy take on the complete role of writing newsletters for the Barony of Oldenfeld.

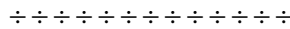
As I continue to say to the populace of Oldenfeld, please submit articles, websites, and any other information that you think would be appropriate for the Olden-

This year's Yule event stewards Gryphen von Kindermann and Charles Ashton ran a

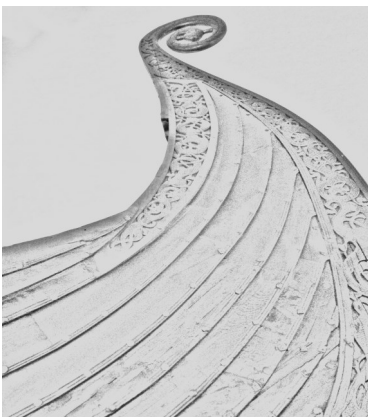
