PANHANDLE SKIRMISHES: November 2nd-4th

Idenfeld and Flintmarsh (Kingdom of Meridies) are jointly hosting this year's

Panhandle Skirmishes event, which will take place at Compass Lake, about 90 minutes west of Tallahassee.

In addition to various heavy combat battle scenarios, there will also be several archery tournaments, including a novelty and a youth shoot. Other live weapons activities are also planned; see the event website for updated information.

Compass Lake allows both tent and RV camping (very limited RV hookups, \$25/night), and there are also limited cabins available for \$65/night, which sleep up to six and are comparable to a motel room. While no feast will be served at this event, there will be two large grills available for free use to prepare your own feast. Breakfast will be provided on Saturday, and a fundraiser lunch will also be available.
