Each quarter Mistress Philomena will share a new period recipe with us. We hope you give it a try and let us know what you think!

This quarter's recipe is one that is easy to make and a sweet treat as we enter Spring. It is a 14th Century recipe for Cryppys, from "Ancient Cookery", a Bodleian manuscript from 1381, that was also included in the second half of Samuel Pegge's 1780 edition of "Forme of Cury" IT reminds me a bit of a funnel cake!



xxvi. For to Make Cryppys

Nym flour and wytys of eyryn sugur other hony and sweyng togedere and mak a batour nym wyte grees and do yt in a posnet and cast the batur thereyn and stury to thou have many and tak hem up and messe hem with the frutours and serve forthe. Translation

Crisps. Take flour and whites of eggs, sugar or honey and mix together to make a batter. Take white grease (lard) and place in a posnet and cast the batter therein and stir it until you have many and take them up and plate them with the fritters and serve forth

| <u>Recipe:</u> - ¼ cup Flour | Directions Over medium heat, melt sufficient lard in a pan to shallow fry the batter | | | |
|--|--|--|--|--|
| 2 Egg Whites 2 tsp Honey | Combine egg whites, water and honey and whisk together. Add egg mixture to flour and mix to create the batter. | | | |
| ¼ cup Water Lard for frying | Use a tablespoon to scoop and drizzle the batter in a spiral pattern into the hot lard (or oil) like a funnel cake | | | |
| Makes about 10 "fritters" | Fry over medium heat until golden brown. Flip to cook evenly. Drain on a paper towel, top with honey or powdered sugar and serve. | | | |
| | The batter for this is very thin. You can add more flour if you'd like a thicker batter. You can add chopped apples if you like and instead fry them like little pancakes or fritters instead and top with cinnamon sugar. | | | |

Minister of Arts & Sciences

The Minister of Arts and Sciences (MoAS) is responsible for promoting and nurturing the research, study, and practice of period-style arts and sciences The arts and sciences include creating Items (calligraphy, needlepoint, soapmaking, leather working, illumination, armor-crafting, etc) as well as performance art (singing, dancing, theater, etc.) Twice a year Oldenfeld hosts local Competitions run by the MoAS, that are Open to anyone who would to enter

The MoAS is a *warranted* officer. This means that they must be approved by a kingdom (state)-level officer of the same type. In this case, the <u>**Trimaris**</u> Minister of Arts and Sciences.

Constable

The Constable's duty is to safeguard the welfare of people who attend Oldenfeld events. Note, that officers of the Constabulary do not have the authority to enforce state/local law; they uphold the law by way of observation, limited intervention, and proper use of the chain of command for Oldenfeld officers. **Constables have no greater legal authority than any normal member of the public.**

In Oldenfeld, our Constable also works to maintain and keep organized our storage unit.

Heavy Weapons Marshal

The Heavy Weapons Marshal is tasked with organizing and supervising the safe, rule-abiding practice of heavy combat. They will also help people get authorized to fight. The Heavy Weapons Marshal is a *warranted* officer. This means that they must be approved by a kingdom (state)-level officer of the same type. In this case, they must be approved by the <u>Trimaris</u> Earl Marshal.

We are also seeking a Deputy Heavy Weapons Marshal.

Baronial Ranger

The Baronial Ranger is in charge of helping potential & current target archers get and stay up-to-date on safety equipment and regulations, and in charge of organizing safe target archery and thrown weapons activities. The Baronial Ranger is a *warranted* officer. This means that they must be approved by a kingdom (state)-level officer of the same type. In this case, they must be approved by the <u>**Trimaris**</u> Captain of the Rangers.
